The ACOVA program, in cooperation with Law Enforcement, area hospitals and other community agencies, provides trained, volunteer Victim Advocates who are available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to crisis situations due to crime or circumstance.

In addition to answering questions regarding victim's rights and/or the criminal justice system, ACOVA Volunteers provide support, information, appropriate resource referrals and follow up to victims, regardless of their ethnicity, religion, age or gender.

Classes will be held Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 6 p.m.-9 p.m. They will start on Aug. 25th and will end on Oct. 6th. All classes are mandatory. The application deadline is Aug. 1st. If you are interested, please call Jan Curtis at 553-2460.
