Woman Arrested for Embezzling Thousands from Former Employer

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's detectives arrested a 52-year-old woman today on a felony warrant in connection with the embezzlement of more than \$240,000 from a Pueblo West business where she had been employed.

Detectives arrested Lisa Baker on the warrant for theft and identity theft following an extensive investigation into the incident. In January 2020, detectives were notified by an owner of P&A Flooring, 631 E. Industrial Blvd., that there had been thousands of dollars in fraudulent charges made on a company credit card.

After an extensive investigation, detectives learned that Baker, who had been the longtime bookkeeper for the business, had used the credit cards to charge more than \$212,000 in personal services, groceries, clothing and online purchases. It was later learned that Baker made another \$41,000 in charges on two additional credit cards belonging to the business.

Based on the investigation, detectives sought and were granted an arrest warrant for Baker. She was arrested without incident and has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail.
