### **UPDATE: Pueblo West Suspicious Death Investigation Now Homicide Investigation**

**Pueblo, CO:** The suspicious death investigation of a 13-year-old girl who was body was found in her home in Pueblo West Monday morning is now being investigated as a homicide.

Pueblo County Sheriff's deputies responded to the home in the 600 block of E. Clarion Drive Monday morning on a report of an unresponsive female. Deputies found the female deceased. She was identified by Pueblo County Coroner Brian Cotter as Haley Perkins.

The death was deemed suspicious due to the age of the victim and pending the results of an autopsy. Following an autopsy Tuesday, Cotter determined the manner of death is homicide. No suspects have been identified.

Pueblo County Sheriff's detectives continue to investigate the incident.
