Deputies Recover Items from Several Pueblo West Burglaries; Suspect Identified

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Office Patrol Deputies recovered numerous items recently reported stolen from Pueblo West homes and businesses after executing a search warrant this morning at a Pueblo West home.

Deputies, who have been actively investigating the recent rash of burglaries, obtained and executed a search warrant at a home in the 200 block of E. Falcon Drive and located numerous reported stolen items, including items from at least three Pueblo West businesses. A vehicle located at the residence was impounded and deputies are seeking a warrant to search that vehicle.

No arrests have been made yet, however deputies have identified a suspect.

"I want to commend our patrol deputies for their diligent and proactive work on these recent burglaries," said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. "They did some old-fashioned police work in tying together several of these burglaries, locating some of the stolen items and identifying a suspect."

The sheriff's office is seeking help from residents and business owners in obtaining any video footage they may have from 2-2:30 a.m. Thursday, February 9, particularly of any suspicious activity or vehicles. Deputies are seeking the video from those residences/businesses on S. Dacona Dr., E. Eads Dr. E. Falcon Drive and S. Wiggins Dr. (Please see the attached map with highlighted streets of where we are seeking video footage.) Anyone with video footage from the highlighted streets are asked to contact the Pueblo County Sheriff's Office at (719) 583-6250.

No additional information regarding these incidents will be released at this time as this is an active an ongoing investigation.
