Deputies, Detectives Recover Stolen Vehicles Found on Property Near Avondale

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Special Investigation Detectives along with Patrol Deputies executed a search warrant late Monday night on property in eastern Pueblo County near the Town of Avondale and recovered numerous stolen vehicles.

As part of an ongoing investigation, detectives and deputies discovered what were believed to be several stolen vehicles on the property in the 52000 block of U.S. Highway 50 East. Detectives sought and executed a warrant to search the property and found numerous stolen vehicles in and around an outbuilding on the property.

Detectives recovered two trucks, a bulldozer, four trailers and a motorcycle. The two trucks, bulldozer and motorcycle were reported stolen. The vehicle identification numbers on all the trailers were removed. However, an enclosed trailer that was recovered had items belonging to a Colorado Springs church. That trailer was reported stolen.

Special Investigation Detectives also seized another pickup truck and a box truck. The pickup truck has been identified as being used in the theft of a trailer and heavy machinery in Canon City. The box truck was with another trailer that had been reported stolen in that same Canon City incident.

No arrests have been made. The investigation is ongoing.
