Sheriff's Office Notified of Sexually Violent Predator Moving into Pueblo West

Pueblo, CO: The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office has been notified, per Colorado law, that Paul Roque Herrera, 55, is relocating from Denver and will live in Pueblo West as of May 8.

Herrera was convicted of sexual exploitation/child-induce/entice (F3) and sexual assault on a child by a person in position of trust (victim under the age of 15)(F3). Herrera has met the criteria to be deemed a sexually violent predator, which requires community notification.

The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office has been advised that Herrera will reside at 942 S. Honeysuckle Dr. in Pueblo West. He will be required to register as a sex offender with the Pueblo County Sheriff's Office every 90 days.

Herrera is described as a Hispanic male, 5-foot-8 inches tall, 170 pounds with a shaved head (brown hair) and brown eyes. He has a tattoo of a cross on the web of his left hand.

The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office is releasing this information pursuant to state statute (16-13-901), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when the offender has been determined to be a sexually violent predator and is subject to community notification.
