Juveniles Face Charges in Robbery, Assault at Pueblo West Convenience Store

Pueblo, CO: Two juveniles will be facing felony charges after Pueblo County Sheriff's deputies quickly identified them as suspects in the early Thursday morning robbery and assault of an employee at a Pueblo West convenience store.

Deputies responded to Loaf N Jug, 136 S. Purcell Blvd., at about 12:20 a.m. with a report of a robbery. When deputies arrived, they contacted an employee who said two females entered the store and one of them took a case of beer and attempted to leave the store without paying for it. The suspect attempted to leave through an exit door that was locked, causing her to bump into the door and drop the beer. The employee said he approached the suspects when one of them hit him in the face with a wine bottle. The employee was treated for a laceration of the face. Both females left the store in an unknown vehicle.

Deputies investigating the incident quickly identified the suspects, ages 15 and 16. The suspects are expected to face charges of aggravated robbery, second-degree assault and criminal mischief.

The investigation into this incident is ongoing.
