Pueblo West Woman Arrested for Felony Child Abuse

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Detectives arrested a 38-year-old Pueblo West woman for child abuse involving her two children, one of whom has suffered life-threatening injuries.

Samantha Kimberly was arrested Saturday night for felony child abuse resulting in serious bodily injury and a second charge of child abuse due to injuries sustained by her two sons, ages 3 and 14. The 3-year-old is in a Colorado Springs hospital with life-threatening injuries. The 14-year-old was treated at a local hospital for his injuries.

Sheriff's deputies responded at about 5 p.m. Saturday to a Pueblo West home on a report that a 3-year-old was unconscious and breathing abnormally. When deputies arrived, medical personnel were attending to the child, who had visible injuries to his body. The child was transported by ambulance to a local hospital and later transported by flight to a hospital in Colorado Springs.

A 14-year-old boy had visible injuries and was taken to a local hospital where he was treated for non-life-threatening injuries. He has been placed with the Department of Human Services.

Following questioning by detectives, Kimberly was arrested in connection with causing injuries to both children. She has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail. Additional charges may be forthcoming.
