Pueblo Man Arrested for Attempted Murder

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Deputies arrested a 33-year-old Pueblo man early Sunday morning (October 6), on an attempted second-degree murder charge stemming from an assault of a 35-year-old woman at her home in Pueblo West.

Deputies responded at about 5:40 a.m. to a residence in the 600 block of Clarion Drive and found a woman with injuries from an assault. The woman told deputies she had been sleeping when she woke to find a man, she knew assaulting her. The man was identified as Jordan Cartmell, 33.

The woman said she was able to break free from Cartmell and was attempting to run away when he hit her in the face. The woman was able to run to a neighbor's home for help. The woman was transported to a local hospital where her injuries were determined to be serious but non-life threatening. She was treated and released from the hospital.

Deputies searched the woman's home and found Cartmell lying on a bed in the house with a self-inflicted wound. He was taken into custody and transported to a local hospital for treatment of his injury. He was later booked into the Pueblo County Jail for attempted second-degree murder, second-degree assault and domestic violence. He remains in jail on a \$175,000 bond.
