### Man Arrested for Selling Marijuana to Middle School Students

**Pueblo, CO:** Pueblo County Sheriff's Special Investigations Narcotics Detectives arrested a 24-year-old Pueblo man Thursday afternoon on several charges stemming from his role in selling marijuana products to middle school-aged students.

Detectives arrested Quentin Marcellus Goodman-Reynolds after he arrived at a location in Pueblo West where detectives had arranged to do an undercover buy. His arrest came following a months-long investigation by narcotics detectives that was sparked by a tip of an adult male selling marijuana to middle school students.

Through the investigation, detectives learned that Goodman-Reynolds contacted juveniles through social media to make sales of marijuana products and delivered the items to them. Some of the students were as young as 13 years old.

A detective posed as a juvenile agreed to meet Goodman-Reynolds at an undisclosed location to purchase some marijuana. When Goodman-Reynolds arrived, he was taken into custody without incident. The vehicle Goodman-Reynolds was driving was seized and detectives are seeking a warrant to search the vehicle.

Goodman-Reynolds was arrested for offenses related to the distribution of marijuana/marijuana concentrate, contributing to the delinquency of a minor, special offender and a protection order violation. He has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail. Further charges could be forthcoming, pending the outcome of the search warrant on Goodman-Reynolds' vehicle.

"Our detectives did a great job investigating this case, identifying the suspect and making an arrest," said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. "This is worrisome that someone is taking advantage of our youth like this. We urge parents to be proactive, be engaged and find out what their kids are doing and who they are communicating with."
