Man Sentenced in Pueblo West Triple Fatal Accident

Pueblo, CO: A 33-year-old man was sentenced today to 54 years in the Colorado Department of Corrections after he pled guilty to three counts of vehicular homicide in an August 2023 triple fatal traffic accident in Pueblo West.

Kohen Kyle was sentenced to three 18-year-sentences, all to be served consecutively, after the court accepted his plea in the August 26, 2023, two-car accident that killed Marie Quintana, 56, of Aurora, Jesus Guerrero-Lopez, 48, of Denver and Quintana's 12-year-old grandson. All three victims were pronounced deceased at the scene.

Sheriff's detectives conducted an extensive investigation of the accident and learned that Kyle was driving at speeds more than 100 mph when his 2015 BMW crossed the center line and hit a 2017 Honda CRV head-on. The impact of the crash caused the BMW to roll, coming to a stop on its top, while the Honda was pushed off the west side of the road. The juvenile, who was a backseat passenger, was ejected from the Honda. The two adults remained in the vehicle.

Kyle has been in the Pueblo County Jail since his arrest on September 28, 2023.
