Detectives Arrest Denver Man in Vandalism at District Attorney's Building

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Office Special Investigations Detectives arrested a 23-year-old man today in connection with the vandalism of the Pueblo County District Attorney's Office.

Detectives identified the suspect as Adrian Matthew Martinez of Denver. Detectives located and arrested Martinez for criminal mischief. He has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

On Sunday morning (10/20), deputies responded to the District Attorney's Office, 701 Court St. on a report of a broken window on the north side of the building. Security camera footage showed a man walking to the building and throwing a large rock at the window. The man was then seen running eastbound through the alley. The rock damaged the window along with an interior wall and a desk.

"I am very grateful for the hard work of my detectives and investigators at the 10th Judicial District Attorney's Office, who quickly identified the suspect, along with the added tips from the community through our Facebook page," said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. "This is a great example of our community working with law enforcement to identify someone who is alleged to have committed this crime and attacked the very institution of justice in our community."
