Deputies Arrest Man Burglarizing Salt Creek Home

Pueblo, CO: The quick response by Pueblo County Sheriff's deputies to a homeowner's call of a burglary in-progress at his Salt Creek home led to the arrest early this morning of a 51-year-old man on several felony charges.

Deputies responded to the 1100 block of San Mateo Street at about 5 a.m. after the property owner reported seeing on security camera, a man entering the home. Deputies quickly arrived and surrounded the home. After giving several verbal commands for anyone inside the home to come out, a man identified as Ramiro Peran came out from a basement crawl space. Peran was arrested without incident.

Through an investigation of the incident, it was learned that Peran was attempting to steal the copper piping in the home and in doing so caused significant damage to utilities at the home. When taking Peran into custody, deputies also found numerous identification and credit cards on him which didn't belong to him.

Peran was arrested for theft, second-degree burglary, criminal mischief, criminal possession of identification documents and criminal possession of four or more financial devices. He has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

"This is another great example of the community working with law enforcement by calling us when they see something suspicious," said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. "Due to the quick reporting, our deputies were able to respond immediately, which allowed them to catch the perpetrator in the act. This was a great job by all involved."
