Sexually Violent Predator Residing in Lombard Village Neighborhood

Pueblo, CO: The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office has been notified by the Colorado Bureau of Investigation Sex Offender Registration Unit that John Lopez, 62, who is deemed a sexually violent predator, is residing in the Lombard Village neighborhood in East Pueblo County.

CBI has notified the Sheriff's Office that Lopez is residing at 1719 Johneva St., has been convicted of child molestation in Indiana. Based on that conviction, the State of Colorado deemed Lopez to be a sexually violent predator.

Lopez is described as a Hispanic male, 5-foot-10 inches tall, 180 pounds with brown/gray hair and brown eyes.

The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office is releasing this information pursuant to state statute (16-13-901), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender residing in their jurisdiction when the offender has been determined to be a sexually violent predator and is subject to community notification.
