### **K9 Assists with Locating Two Men in Auto Salvage Yard Burglary**

**Pueblo, CO:** Pueblo County Sheriff's Deputies, with help from K9 Zeus, located and arrested two men for burglarizing a Pueblo County auto salvage yard Thursday night.

Deputies responded to Daurios Auto Truck, 3701 E. Eighth St., at about 9 p.m. after the owner reported seeing on security cameras, two men in the yard. Deputies, including K9 Zeus and handler Deputy Chris Carter, quickly responded and began searching the yard. Deputies gave several verbal commands for the suspects to surrender, but they did not comply.

K9 Zeus located one suspect, Antonio Factor, 27, hiding under a car. K9 Zeus held Factor until deputies were able to get him into custody. K9 Zeus then located the second suspect, Aaron Cleghorn, 39, a short distance away also hiding under a car. Upon seeing Zeus, Cleghorn surrendered and was taken into custody.

Factor and Cleghorn were each arrested for second-degree burglary, criminal mischief and conspiracy. Factor also had an outstanding warrant. Factor and Cleghorn were booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

"Deputies did a great job of securing the perimeter around this business and then with the assistance of our K9, was able to quickly get these suspects into custody," said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. "I also commend the business owner for immediately calling us when he saw the suspicious activity in the yard. Great work by all involved."
