Deputies Arrest Parolee Wanted on a DOC Warrant

Pueblo, CO: For a second time in two days, Pueblo County Sheriff's Deputies arrested a parolee wanted on a Colorado Department of Corrections felony warrant.

Deputies arrested Anthony C. Loudy, 36, on Tuesday after responding to a shoplifting call at Dollar General, 1610 Santa Fe Dr. Deputies responded to the store at about 2:15 p.m. after an employee reported a suspicious man in the store who they believed was concealing items in his coat. When deputies arrived, they saw a man, later identified as Loudy, who matched the description of the suspect leaving the store, walking westbound.

When Loudy saw the deputy, he ran and attempted to climb a fence to get away. The deputy gave several verbal commands for Loudy to stop running and lay on the ground. Loudy initially complied with the order, but while being questioned by the deputy, Loudy got up and ran. The deputy yelled for Loudy to stop running, but when he again refused, the deputy deployed a Taser and was able to take Loudy into custody.

Loudy gave deputies two false names before his fingerprints positively identified him. Deputies then learned that DOC wanted Loudy on a fugitive extradition unit warrant. In a routine search of Loudy, deputies located several items that he had taken from the Dollar General.

Loudy was arrested on the warrant and new charges of criminal impersonation, resisting arrest, and theft. He was booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

Loudy is the second person with a DOC warrant that deputies have arrested this week. On Sunday, a deputy who stopped to assist with a stalled vehicle arrested Gerald Rodriguez, 36, who was wanted on a felony warrant from DOC.
