Detectives Assist with Arrest of Man Wanted by Trinidad PD

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Special Investigations and Narcotics detectives working with the U.S. Marshals Violent Task Force arrested a 30-year-old man Wednesday, who was wanted by Trinidad Police on a fugitive of justice warrant for several felony charges, including attempted second-degree murder.

Detectives located Neal Helmbrecht at an apartment on Norman Lane in the City of Pueblo at about 4:15 p.m. and took him into custody without incident. Helmbrecht was wanted in connection with a home invasion in Trinidad in March.

Helmbrecht was arrested for attempted second-degree murder, second-degree assault, first-degree burglary, robbery and a protection order violation. He was booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

"This is another example of the great partnership we have in working with the U.S. Marshals Task Force to seek out, apprehend and arrest wanted fugitives," said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. "Given the seriousness of this suspect's crimes, I am glad that this suspect was arrested safely and without incident."
