Traffic Stop Leads to Seizure of Guns and Assortment of Drugs

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Special Investigations and Narcotics Detectives recently conducted a traffic stop of a vehicle believed to be involved in the distribution of narcotics and recovered an assortment of illegal drugs and two guns.

After stopping the vehicle, which was occupied by several people, detectives seized it and sought a search warrant. The search warrant was granted and executed. Detectives located two guns, including one that was fully automatic, and the following drugs:

- 10 grams of Fentanyl pills
- 38 grams of methamphetamine
- Approximately 1 gram of heroin
- 268 grams of powder suspected to be narcotics
- 15 grams of crystalline substance believed to be narcotics
- 85 grams of psilocybin mushrooms
- 1 syringe filled with suspected narcotics

Detectives also seized other items of evidence believed to be used in the illegal distribution/sale of narcotics.

No arrests have been made, but charges will be forthcoming. The investigation is ongoing. No further information will be released at this time.
