One Arrested Following Assault at Runyon Field

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's deputies arrested a man on felony assault charges following a fight Sunday evening at Runyon Field Sports Complex that left two people injured, including one with serious injuries.

Pueblo County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Runyon Field at about 5:10 p.m. on a report of a fight. When deputies arrived, medical personnel were attending to an unconscious 46-year-old man. The man was taken to a local hospital with serious injuries. A second man was also injured in the altercation. He was treated for minor injuries.

Witnesses told deputies that a group of people were leaving the field when two women started arguing. Two men attempted to defuse the situation when one of the men was hit in the face by another man. The victim went unconscious and fell to the ground. A second man was injured when he was hit with a baseball bat by another man. Both suspects left the area after the assaults.

Deputies were able to identify possible suspects and went to a home in the City of Pueblo to try to contact them. When deputies arrived at the residence, they contacted Armando Carbajal, 52, who was identified as the suspect with the baseball bat. Carbajal was arrested for second-degree assault, felony menacing, and on an outstanding warrant. He was booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

The second suspect was seen at the home when deputies arrived, but left on foot before deputies could contact him. Deputies searched the area for the man but were unable to find him. Charges are forthcoming.

This is an ongoing investigation, and no further information will be released at this time.
