New Law Requires Those Seeking Concealed Handgun Permit to Take Training

Pueblo, CO: Pueblo County Sheriff's Office is reminding those who will be seeking a new or renewing a concealed carry permit that you will now be required to take and pass a handgun training class taught by a verified instructor before obtaining a permit.

A new law effective July 1 requires all new concealed carry permit applicants to take an in-person handgun training course, which includes a written test and live-fire training. Applicants must achieve a minimum score of 80% on the written test and 70% on the live-fire portion of the training.

Also, beginning July 1, those seeking to renew their concealed handgun permit must complete a minimum 2-hour refresher course that includes a written exam and live-fire training.
