Deputies' Quick Response Leads to Arrest of Two for Burglary

Pueblo, CO: Rapid response by Pueblo County Sheriff's deputies to a burglary in progress call early this morning on private property just east of the Pueblo city limits ended with two arrests and the recovery of some stolen items.

Deputies responded to the 1800 block of S. La Crosse Avenue at about 1 a.m. on a burglary alarm that was called in after an RV owner reported seeing on a security camera, a man break into his trailer. During the break-in, the suspect also took down the security camera.

Within 9 minutes of receiving the call, deputies arrived and saw two men take off running through the fenced property. Deputies chased the men while repeatedly giving them orders to stop running. The suspect refused the order; however, a deputy was able to quickly apprehend one of the suspects, identified as Steven Griego, 36. The second suspect, identified as Deyon Jaramillo, 31, ran into some brush and hid but was quickly located and taken into custody.

Deputies searched the property and found several items that were reportedly taken from the RV, including the security camera. Deputies also discovered that several other RVs on the property had been broken into; however, it is unknown if anything was taken until the owners of those RVs are contacted.

Jaramillo, who had a Denver address, was arrested for second-degree burglary, theft, resisting arrest, criminal mischief, and a fugitive warrant. Griego was arrested for second-degree burglary, resisting arrest, criminal mischief, theft, and three outstanding warrants.

The investigation is ongoing, and further charges may be forthcoming.
