Sexually Violent Predator Residing in Pueblo West

Pueblo, CO: The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office has received notification that Guillermo Gomez, 75, who is deemed a sexually violent predator, is now residing in Pueblo West.

Gomez, who is residing at 1033 N. Purcell Boulevard, was convicted of sex assault of a child under age 15 by a person in a position of trust. Based on that conviction, the State of Colorado deemed Gomez to be a sexually violent predator.

Gomez is described as a Hispanic male, 5-foot-5 inches tall, 145 pounds, with brown/gray hair and brown eyes.

The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office is releasing this information pursuant to state statute (16-13-901), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender residing in their jurisdiction when the offender has been determined to be a sexually violent predator and is subject to community notification.
