Pueblo County Sheriff's Office assists U.S. Marshals, U.S. Marshal Task Force, Capture Two Juvenile Escapees in Pueblo

Pueblo, CO: The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office, which is part of the U.S. Marshals Task Force, working with the other Task Force officers from the surrounding area and Deputy U.S. Marshals, arrested two juveniles early this morning, who had escaped in September from a youth detention facility in Colorado Springs.

At 12:09 a.m., Task Force Officers/Deputies and Deputy U.S. Marshals went to an apartment in the 1000 block of W. 13th Street after receiving information that the fugitives, Dameron Carbajal, 17, and Cristian Jaramillo, 17, both of Pueblo, were inside. The two had been on the run since escaping on September 22, 2025, from the Spring Creek Youth Services Center in Colorado Springs.

Upon arrival, law enforcement announced their presence and instructed occupants to remain inside. Several individuals attempted to flee through a window, but officers maintained a secure perimeter and requested additional units to assist in securing the area. At 12:23 a.m., officers entered the apartment and arrested Carbajal and Jaramillo without incident. Both were booked into the Pueblo Youth Services Center.

During a protective sweep of the apartment, detectives observed firearms, ammunition, and suspected narcotics in plain view. Pueblo County Sheriff's Office detectives seized three Glock handguns with extended magazines – one modified to be fully automatic – an AR-style rifle with a high-capacity magazine, additional firearms, an open safe containing suspected narcotics, a large amount of cash, digital scales, and other items consistent with drug distribution. The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office will handle the ongoing criminal investigation related to the guns and narcotics found, as well as the harboring of the wanted juveniles.

Several individuals were found in the home. One adult male, Dylan Vanluven, 22, was arrested on an unrelated warrant out of El Paso County. He has been booked into the Pueblo County Jail.

Carbajal was serving a five-year sentence for attempted murder, and Jaramillo was serving a four-year sentence for felony kidnapping, both out of Pueblo County. They were also wanted on no-bond warrants for escape from custody.



“This was a coordinated and professional effort by our PCSO detectives, Deputy U.S. Marshals and partner agencies,” said Pueblo County Sheriff David J. Lucero. “Because of their teamwork, two wanted escapees were safely taken back into custody, and additional criminal activity was uncovered that will be pursued through further investigation.”

U.S. Marshal for Colorado Kirk M. Taylor added, “My team of Deputy Marshals worked incredibly hard to capture these two fugitives. We could not have done it without the help and support of the Task Force Officers and both the Pueblo County Sheriff’s Office and the Pueblo Police Department.”
