Sexually Violent Predator Residing in Pueblo West

Pueblo, CO: The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office has received notification that Jason Allen Fay, 39, who is deemed a sexually violent predator, is now residing in Pueblo West. Fay is living at 1153 W. Meadowmoor Drive.

Fay was convicted of second-degree assault and attempted sexual assault on a victim in an incapable condition. Based on that conviction, the State of Colorado deemed Fay to be a sexually violent predator.

Fay is described as a Hispanic male, 6-foot-1 inches tall, 201 pounds, with red hair and hazel eyes. Fay has numerous tattoos on his arms, legs, torso, neck, face, and his eyes.

The Pueblo County Sheriff's Office is releasing this information pursuant to state statute (16-13-901), which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender residing in their jurisdiction when the offender has been determined to be a sexually violent predator and is subject to community notification.
